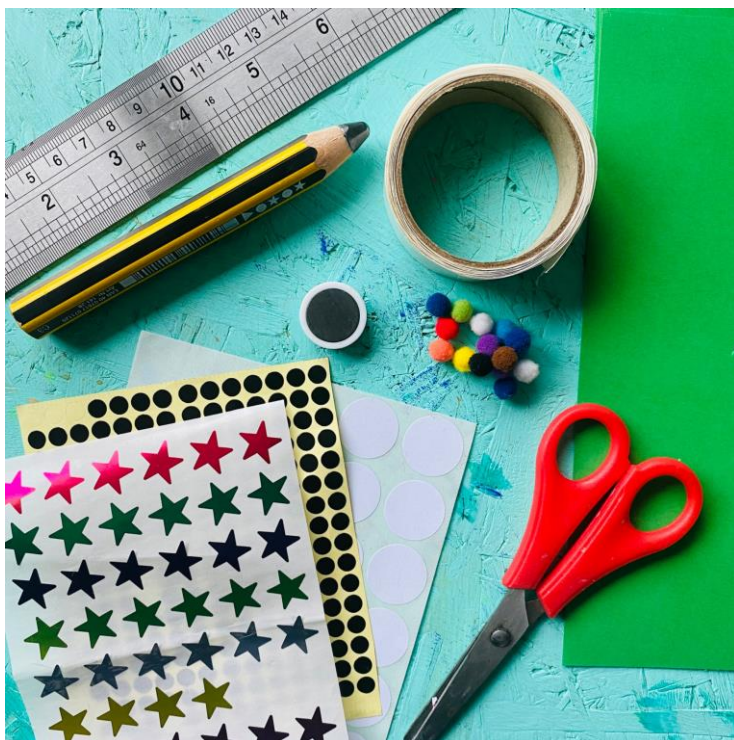


Festive Finger Puppet Mini Make for children (and grownups)

Make and play with these fun puppets made from materials often found at home over the holidays. Put on your own puppet shows for your friends and family. This make was inspired by an image in a vintage craft book for children called Making Things with Patricia Driscoll. We made a tree but you can make anything you like.



You will need:



Coloured paper or card

Pencil

Ruler (or something with a straight edge)

Stickers

Mini pom poms (optional)

If you don't have stickers or pom poms you can use pen or pencil to decorate the puppet

Glue stick or glue dots

Some small and circular to draw around

Scissors or craft knife

Step by step - making the finger puppet

Cut a triangle from card or paper



Use a small circular object to draw two circles (these need to be big enough for your index and middle finger to fit through). We used a fridge magnet but a coin would work too.



Cut out the circles to create two holes. You can either fold gently along the diameter of the circle and use scissors or keep the puppet flat and use a craft knife to cut the circles out.



Decorating your puppet

Use drawn decoration/stickers or pom poms to make your puppet come to life. Ut your fingers through the holes and make your puppet walk along.
